Dr. Doria is retired from the U.S. military, and is a combat veteran who was the sole Clinical Neuropsychologist and Program Manager of the U.S. Coast Guard's Psychological Health (PH) and Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) Programs. He was responsible for establishing and institutionalizing two service-wide comprehensive interdisciplinary programs, focusing on prevention, training, treatment, and tracking of PH and TBI cases promoting total health across the entire Coast Guard. In 2017, Dr. Doria established NeuroPsychCPS, LLC to provide trusted, quality assessments and evaluations, clinical treatments, training and consultative services for individuals suffering from mental health disorders. In addition, Dr. Doria assisted people and organizations in the community who were recovering from the distress caused by disruptive workplace tragedies throughout New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut.

Experience the convenience of skipping the traditional office visit by welcoming a provider into your digital home. Through your smartphone, tablet, or computer, there is no travel, no waiting rooms, just simple convenience.

On July 10, 2019, Dr. Doria introduced Vets Treating Vets, Inc. (VTV) a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation public charity (Tax ID Number: 84-2126324) that provides a telemental health service exclusively for U.S. veterans by veterans. VTV will deliver mental health services using remote technologies when the patient (the veteran, military, dependent's, and their families) and the provider (a licensed clinician veteran or a licensed clinician dependent, or a veteran peer) are separated by distance. This specialized service enables veterans (at an affordable reduced cost) to meet with a provider through live remote clinical videoconferencing. It is a new critical tool to improve veterans' access to immediate emergency mental health care.
